

Celebrating 200 years of selenium

On the **23 September**, **1817** in a letter to A. Marcet **Jöns Jacob Berzelius** reported that by roasting 200 kg of sulfur he obtained about 3 g of a precipitate. At first he wrongly assigned it as tellurium, but, some months later, he proved that a new element was isolated which he named **"selenium"**.
